School Uniform

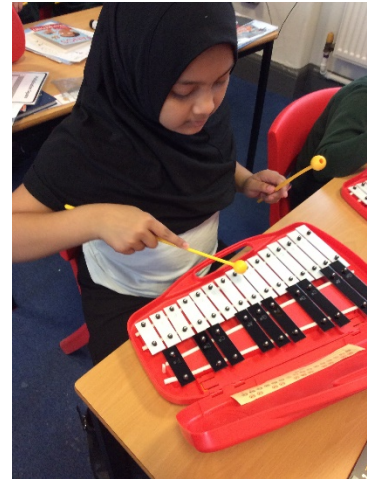

Please can I remind parents and children that **TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS ARE NOT SCHOOL UNIFORM**. Any children who are currently wearing tracksuit bottoms to school will need to be in full school uniform (trouser, dress or skirt) at the start of term 6 **AT THE LATEST**. We will be contacting families directly in Term 6 if any child does not arrive at school in full school uniform. Please note that **LEGGINS can only be worn under a skirt** (in place of tights) and not as a replacement for trousers or a skirt.
