## Year 2

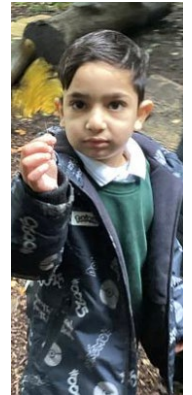
Year 2 used their science learning to inspire some art. They used watercolour to paint the solar system
