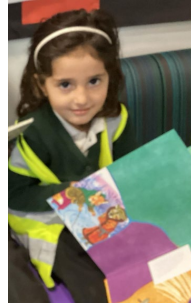


Term 1 newsletter

In science, Year 4 made string telephones to explore how sound travels. It was fun testing them out and seeing how the sound moved from one cup to the other



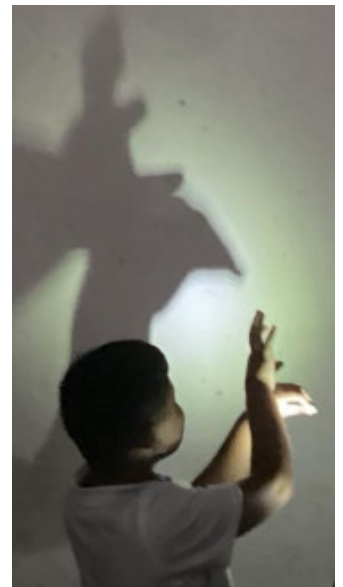
Year 6
