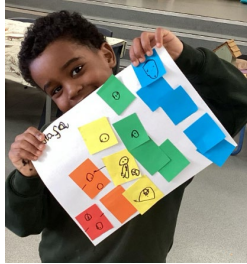
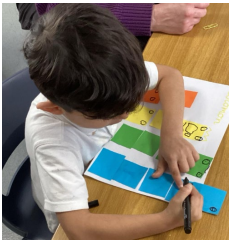

We have had a great term!

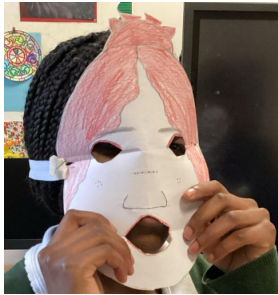
Reception class

Year 1 and Year 5 enjoyed a joint visit to J3. They shared stories together. We love reading!



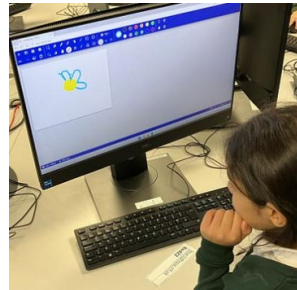
Year 6

Year 2

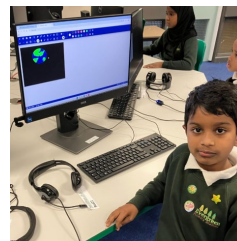
Year 2 have been computer scientists. They have learnt lots of new skills.



MP visit

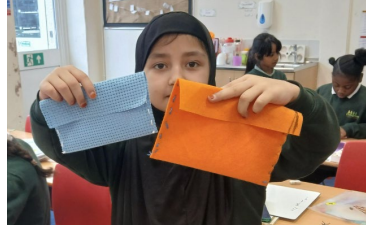
Evergreen was lucky and welcomed Kerry McCarthy, local MP, to school.

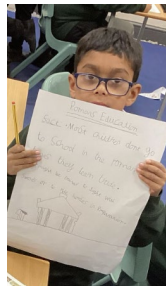
Year 1

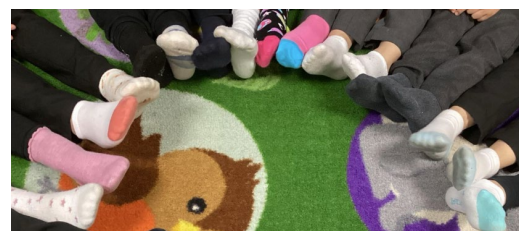
Year 4
