Across the school, we celebrated World Hijab Day. We learnt about why individuals wear them and designed our own hijabs.

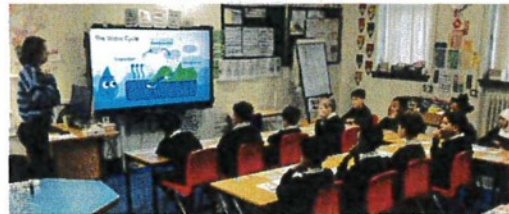
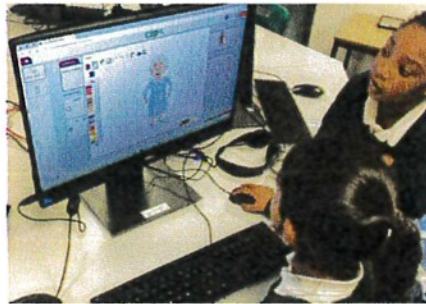
Year 1
