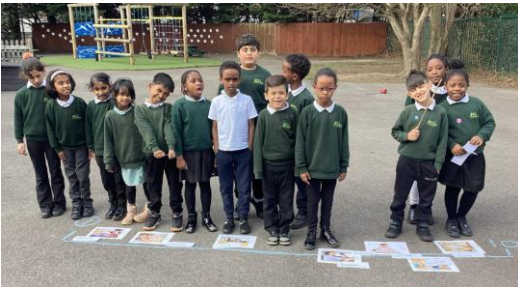


The children love playing together at lunchtimes!
