Year 4 and Year R had an exciting time at The Wild Place. They saw lots of interesting animals and had lots of fun!



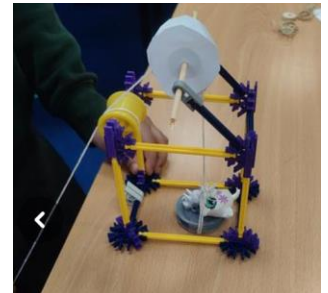
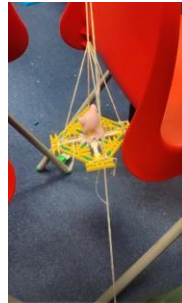
Forest school learning
