Year 6 took their art learning outside. Their sketches were incredible!



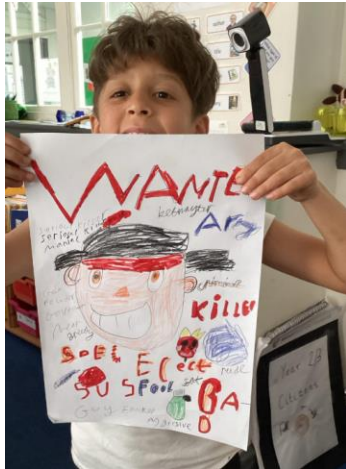
Visit to City Academy
