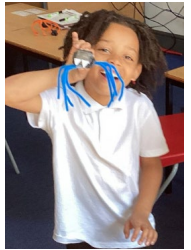
Year 1

At Evergreen, we take our learning outside lots. We celebrated outdoor learning day with even more learning outside!



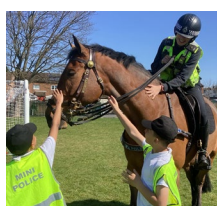
Year 3

As authors, Year 3 made spiders and then went on to write stories about the scary pets they made!



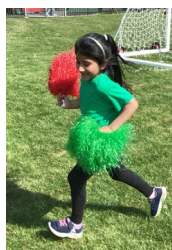
Year 4

It was lovely to celebrate EID together in the sunshine on the school field. Thank you to the families who brought food to share.



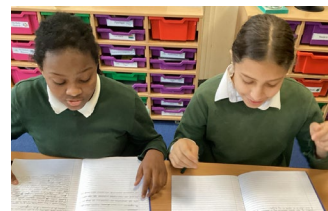
Attendance
