Year 3

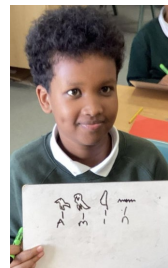
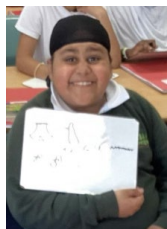
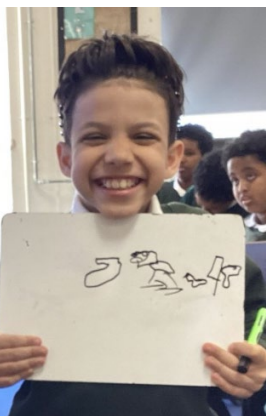
Year 3 performed at Bristol Beacon. They were amazing!
