3	Games with a PEGI 3 rating are suitable for all ages. For example: Rocket League Mario Kart 8 Animal Crossing Team Sonic Racing
7	Games with a PEGI 7 rating are suitable for ages 7 and above. For example: Minecraft Roblox Splatoon Plants Vs Zombies Garden Warfare 2
12	Games with a PEGI 12 rating are suitable for ages 12 and above. For example: Fortnite Overwatch Super Smash Bros. Ultimate Marvel Ultimate Alliance 3
16	Games with a PEGI 16 rating are suitable for ages 16 and above. For example: Marvel's Avengers Final Fantasy VII Remake Horizon Zero Dawn
18	Games with a PEGI 18 rating are suitable for ages 18 and above. For example: Call of Duty Grand Theft Auto
