

Online safety tips for parents of primary school children

Agree on boundaries – be clear about what your child can and can't do online.

Keep phones out of the bedroom at night.

Put yourself in control – set parental controls on your home broadband and any internet-enabled devices.

Explore together – talk to your children about what they do online.



Search safely – make sure safe search is activated on Google and other search engines.

Check if it's suitable – for example, the minimum age limit is 13 years old for several social networking sites.

Stay involved – encourage your children to use their tech devices in a shared space.

Talk to siblings – encourage them to be responsible and help keep their younger siblings safe.
