Authors




As authors, we will be reading Stick Man.

We will be creating our own stick people, exploring the different uses for sticks and taking our sticks on an adventure. We will also be learning to use different adjectives to describe what our sticks look and feel like. We will eventually apply our knowledge when writing simple sentences about what our sticks have been doing in the form of a diary.

Ask us all about our book and stick people at home $-\mathrm{I}$ am sure we will be very excited to discuss it with you!

Mathematicians



As mathematicians, we will be deepening our knowledge and understanding of numbers within 100, by comparing quantities (using more than and less than). We will also be investigating parts of numbers, looking in-depth at numbers 0 to 5 and also exploring shapes.

As a class we will also be practising our number formations up to 10.

Scientists



As scientists, we will be exploring materials, including as wood, glass, plastic and metal.

We will discuss what materials are used for, what properties they have (are they soft, hard, waterproof, stretchy) and we will investigate what material is best for making a tent for a teddy bear and why.

We will be using a range of new vocabulary to explain our learning as scientists!

Athletes



Our athlete lessons for Term 2 are on **Monday and Tuesday**.

Children should come to school dressed ready for athlete lessons.

As athletes, we will be practising and refining our basic movement skills. These will be developed and enhanced through our Real PE curriculum. We will be focussing on our physical cog throughout Term 2.

We are very excited to have Bristol Sport sessions again this term as well as dance.

Phonics



As readers and writers this term, we will be recapping our phase 2 and 3 phonics sounds, before beginning to learn our phase 4 sounds.

<u>At home learning</u>



Please listen to your child read at home 5 times per week. This is the most important thing you can do to support learning at this age. Just 5 minutes per day makes a big difference. Don't forget to ask your child to identify the sounds in the words — they will be very keen to show off their phonics skills!

We will be checking yellow reading records weekly and will change books when appropriate.
