Authors



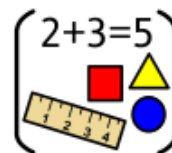
As authors this term, we are reading **Stick Man**.

Mathematicians

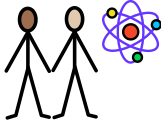


As mathematicians, we will be deepening our knowledge and understanding of numbers within 10.

As a class we will continue to practice number formations and making and breaking numbers to 10, before looking at odd and even number patterns, being able to count 2 more and 2 less and investigating more about zero.

Why not ask us to sing you our number bond song? We use this to help us add to 10.

Scientists



As scientists this term we will be investigating Everyday Materials.

We will be looking at man-made and natural materials, exploring their properties and understanding why different objects are made using different materials.

This will link to our authors story of Stick Man and help us with understanding textiles for our designers week.

Athletes



Our athlete lessons for Term 2 are on **Thursday**.

Children should come to school dressed ready for athlete lessons.

As athletes this term we will explore shape and movement through our Real PE physical cog curriculum.

We are very excited to have Bristol Robins coaches also running sports sessions this term.

Phonics



As readers and writers this term, we will be recapping Phase 4 consonant blends, as well as the Phase 4 common exception words.

We will also continue to recap Phase 3 and Phase 2 phonemes, graphemes and the spelling of some of the common exception words.

Please remember to ask us about our phonics at home.

At home learning



Please listen to your child read at home **5 times per week**. This is the most important thing you can do to support learning at this age. *Just 5 minutes per day makes a big difference.*

Don't forget to ask your child to identify the sounds in the words – they will be very keen to show off their phonics skills!

We will be regularly checking if your child has been reading and will change home reading books when appropriate. Enjoy reading together!
