Readers and Writers

This term, we will study the book 'The Pirates next door' by Jonny Duddle.

We will focus on using the book to explore language and have an end of unit outcome of writing an adventure narrative.



In our morning reading sessions, we will be building our reading comprehension skills and be able to answer questions about texts. We will also continue to practise our retelling skills and be able to make predictions and inferences from our reading.



In this term, we will be consolidating our understanding of number, the four operations and fractions.

We will be developing our skills of reasoning and problem solving with all areas of our maths learning.

We will continue to develop our skills of recalling the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

<u>History</u>

The children will be focusing on 'Being an Historian' this term. They will develop their understanding of the skills needed to be an effective historian. They will be using them skills to explore life in the Victorian times.





For this term, children in Year 2 will be developing their skills at 'Being an athlete' with Bristol Sports support.

The children will continue to have PE every **Tuesday** and **Thursday**.



Please listen to your child read at home 5 times per week. This is the most important thing you can do to support learning at this age.
