<u>Authors</u>



As authors, we will be reading Around the World with Max and Lemon. We will be using our Phase 2, 3, 4 and 5 phonics to independently segment and blend words to independently read sentences in the book. We will be using a range of exciting adjectives and conjunctions to compare and contrast locations.

We are going to use our great oracy skills to discuss, retell and act out our story. Ask us all about our book at home $-\,\mathrm{I}$ am sure we will be very excited to discuss it with you!

<u>Mathematicians</u>



As mathematicians, we will be deepening our knowledge and understanding of numbers within 100. We will be exploring fractions. We will be learning about multiplication. We are always keen to use our strategies... I wonder if we can teach you at home!

As a class we will also be practising our number formations up to 10 and beyond in every activity we do.

We will have maths homework weekly based on our in-class learning. Please remember to complete and return to school!

Geographers













As geographers, we will be comparing different locations — Sabah and Bristol. We will explore both natural and man-made features of each location and discuss the similarities and differences.

We will be using a range of new vocabulary to explain our learning as geographers!

Athletes



As athletes, we will be practising and refining our basic movement skills. These will be developed and enhanced through our Real PE curriculum. This term, we will be focussing on our cognitive cog.

We are very excited to have Bristol Sport sessions this term which will help us to develop our athlete characteristics through sport.

Phonics



As readers and writers, we will be finishing off our Year 2 spelling rules in our daily spelling sessions, alongside learning our phase 5 sounds regularly.

We will have a spelling test every Friday. Please practise your weekly spelling words at home!

At home learning



Please listen to your child read at home 5 times per week. This is the most important thing you can do to support learning at this age. Just 5 minutes per day makes a big difference. Don't forget to ask your child to identify the sounds in the words — they will be very keen to show off their phonics skills!

We will be checking yellow reading records weekly and will change books when appropriate.
