### Authors

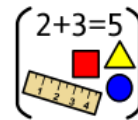


As authors, we will be reading Into the Forest. We will be using a range of exciting adjectives and conjunctions to write an alternative ending to the story.

### Mathematicians



As mathematicians, we will be exploring column addition and column subtraction.

We will continue to explore multiplication with our daily times table booklet work, focusing on our 5x table.

### Scientists

## At home learning
