

Readers and Writers



This term, we will study the book 'James and the Giant Peach' which was written by Roald Dahl. We will be focussing on describing characters and settings as well as sequencing events.

We will continue to practise and develop our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills within our writing sessions with a key focus on using subordinating conjunctions and fronted adverbials

Alongside this, children will learn key reading skills including learning and defining new vocabulary, inferring why the author has used particular words and inferring a characters thoughts and feelings..

Mathematicians



For this term, we will be focussing on measure then moving on to a focus on fractions.

We will first be looking at measuring accurately and

correctly using the correct unit of measurement before moving on to comparing lengths. We will also continue to practise our addition and subtraction skills within this unit.

We will then be moving on to fractions where we will be looking at the part-whole relationship, finding halves, thirds and wholes as well as adding and subtracting fractions.

Encourage your child to log in to TTrockstars as much as possible. As noted last term, a solid grounding in basic number skills really supports you child with the knowledge of all mathematical skills.

We are Historians



In History, we will be looking at European Explorers.

We will particularly be focussing on 'The Age of Exploration', a time where many new places were discovered. We will be investigating why people may become explorers and their reasons for setting out on voyages. We will also be exploring what conditions were like on ships during these expeditions with lots of fun drama activities.


We will also be studying famous explorers at this time including Sir Walter Raleigh, Sir Francis Drake and John Cabot.

We are citizens (Jigsaw)


This term we will be looking at the unit
