Readers and Authors



This term, we will study the book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope', which was written by Joe Todd-Stanton. We will be focussing on using expanded noun phrases for character and setting descriptions. We will also

be writing a diary entry from Arthur's point of view.

We will continue to practise and develop our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills within our writing sessions.

Alongside this, children will learn key reading skills including skimming and scanning a text to find information, making predictions, as well as how to answer questions that require the retrieval of facts from a text.

Mathematicians



In this term, we will be identifying right angles in shapes including polygons. We will further investigate these shapes by drawing and rotating them.

We will then move onto multiplication and division where we will be focussing on the 3,6- and 9-times table. We will then use related multiplication facts to solve problems. It is fundamental that your child continues to log into Times Tables Rockstars to continue their multiplication practise.

We are Evergreen citizens

This term our jigsaw unit is 'Celebrating Differences'. We will discuss judgements and assumptions and their impact. We will also discuss bullying, what it is and how we can problem-solve a bullying situation with others. We will also be celebrating our special qualities and what makes us unique.


We are scientists

As scientists we will be looking at **Electricity**. We will explore different appliances we may have in our

homes and how we can stay safe around them. We will also be understanding simple and series circuits, insulators and conductors and carrying out practical experiments to see these in action.

We are historians

This term we will be travelling back to the Anglo-Saxon era. We will identify and discuss significant individuals within this time period. We will also discuss significant events within this period and their legacy. We will place dates in chronological order and use evidence from our learning to support this.



Our PE days this term are **Wednesday and Thursday**. On Wednesday, Miss Gilbert will be teaching Real Gymnastics with a focus on the physical cog. On Thursday, Bristol Sport will be teaching hockey.



We are continuing to use an individualised spelling programme across the school. Your children will have 16 spellings to learn every week as part of their homework and it is very important that they are supported to learn these before being tested on a Friday morning.



For homework, children have their weekly spelling list as outlined above. They will be set Timestable rockstars activities for them to access online at https://play.ttrockstars.com/

We have a new library which the children will use every week. Children are expected to read for **20 minutes every day**. Please support your child in encouraging them to read daily. Reading bookmarks will be checked on a **Friday**.
