

Curriculum Newsletter Year 5 Term 6 2024/2025


Welcome back to school for term 6. This is the final term in year 5 before they move up to year 6! We have lots packed into this term to help support year 5s transition, including a few exciting trips.

To support your child encourage them to read each day.					


